GLOBAL MALARIA ACTION PLAN

Objective 1: Near zero malaria deaths by 2015

❖ Target 1.1 Achieve universal access to case management in the public sector.

By end 2013, 100% of suspected cases receive a malaria diagnostic test and 100% of confirmed cases receive treatment with appropriate and effective antimalarial drugs.

❖ Target 1.2 Achieve universal access to case management, or appropriate referral, in the private sector.

By end 2015, 100% of suspected cases receive a malaria diagnostic test and 100% of confirmed cases receive treatment with appropriate and effective antimalarial drugs.

❖ Target 1.3 Achieve universal access to community case management (CCM) of malaria

By end 2015, 100% of fever cases receive a malaria diagnostic test and 100% of confirmed uncomplicated cases receive treatment with appropriate and effective antimalarial drugs, and 100% of suspected and confirmed severe cases receive appropriate referral and treatment

Complementary Activities planned for 2013

❖ **Support adaptation of T3 (test, treat, track)**

- Advocate and coordinate RDT quantification with HWG, PSM
- Coordinate with GF market dynamics advisory group on private sector diagnostics scale up
- Collaborate with US PMI on review of supervision/ training tools
- Share partner experience and challenges on scaling up injectable and rectal artesunate
- Coordinate with MERG on implementing malaria surveillance guidelines
- Technical support for developing PV plans in GF proposals
- Assist GMP in developing and disseminating guidance on containing drug resistance for pharmaceutical industry
- Assist GMP and NMCPs in planning China's drug donation program

❖ **Promote iCCM where facility-based care is not available**
